Deadline:

Deadline for entries is <u>March 1, 2023</u>. Winners will be announced at the 2023 CSIA Spring Labor Conference French Lick Springs Hotel, May 1st – May 3rd French Lick, IN.

Entry Fee: There is a \$400 entry fee to have your safety plan reviewed by CSIA Legal Counsel. In return, you will receive a detailed, written critique of the information provided with your application.
